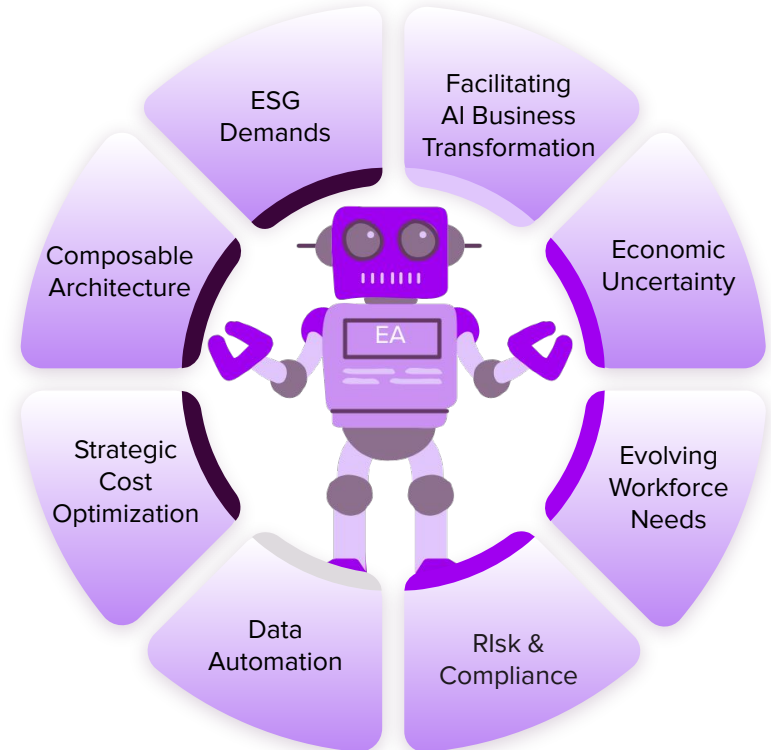

All Businesses are now IT-businesses

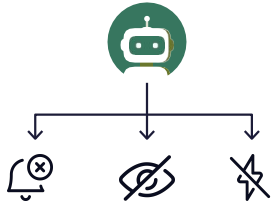
The rise of the business technologist

AI identifies opportunities that might be missed by human analysis



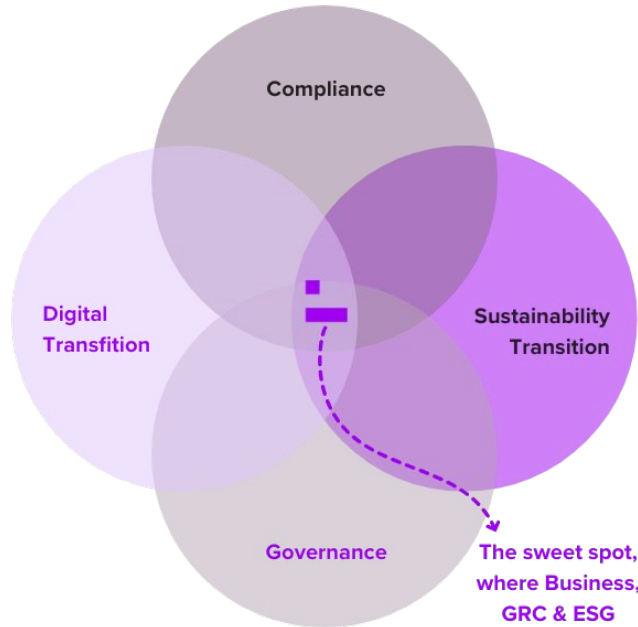
#3 Connecting Compliance, Digital, and Sustainability Goals with EA

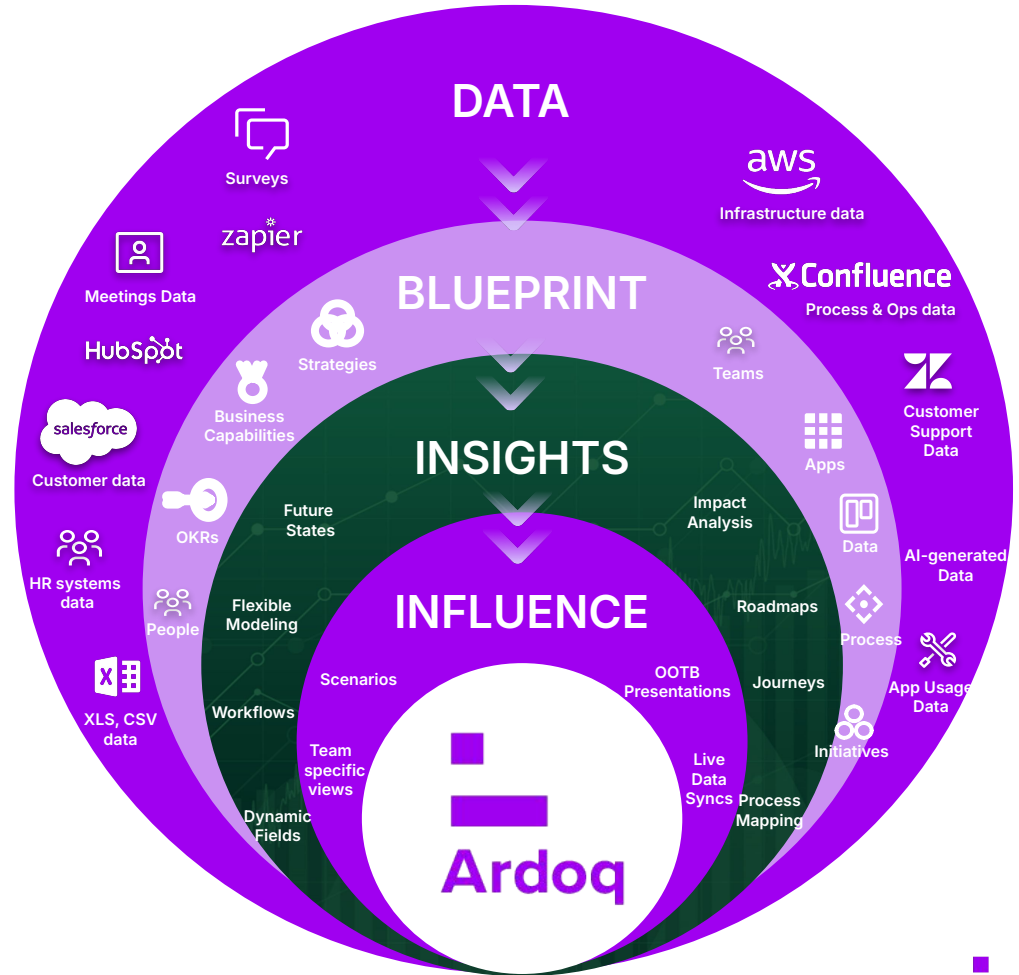
