


Sandbox Environments

A safe, secure and separate environment for developing, testing and validating ideas.

What is a Sandbox?

An Ardoq Sandbox is a separate environment where you can experiment and test Ardoq capabilities without the risk of unwanted changes in your live production environment.

A Sandbox is hosted in the cloud with the same security and specifications as production environments. You can make a Sandbox your own personal playground or invite others to join. Start by cloning data from production or adding new data from other sources.



Data from your sandbox can be moved, but will not merge or synchronize back to production.

When is a Sandbox helpful?

Sandboxes are perfect for architects and developers in a variety of situations.



Onboard new users

Give architects and business users the ideal place to learn Ardoq.



Configure Discover

Set up Discover for users and ensure information is correct before rolling out to a wider audience.



Build or improve metamodels

A Sandbox is the perfect place to build, edit and troubleshoot metamodels before deploying into your live environment.



Test functionality

Build surveys, schedule broadcasts, try new functionality and feel confident about the results.



Try new use cases

Host a new bundle, add data, and see how you can take advantage of Ardoq's preconfigured use case assets.



Test integrations

Test integrations with Azure, AWS or other vendors to make sure they work as expected.
